Overview: This course provides Users with the knowledge and skills to utilize their profile, the role-based directory, and successfully receive/confirm alerts from SIREN.

Who Should Attend: This course is intended for users with Alerting level licenses (This course is a prerequisite for **ALL** additional SIREN training courses).

At Course Completion: After completing this training session, users should be able to access the SIREN portal, update their personal profile information, access the role-based directory, access the document center, and receive/confirm alerts via multimedia devices.

IDPH is deploying **SIREN** (State of Illinois Rapid Electronic Notification) as our new Health Alert Network (HAN) emergency notification tool. The HAN will provide rapid, confidential, secure, web-based alerting and communication and will prove most effective for our mission in emergency public health response for such events as the H1N1 Influenza preparedness efforts allowing rapid electronic notification to IDPH employees and external Public Health partners. It will also facilitate many of IDPH's activities in the areas of emergency response, outbreak notification and investigation, and include employee emergency notification for building emergencies, weather closures and other business continuity/disaster recovery related events.
