Since 2013, the Illinois and Chicago departments of public health have worked with stakeholders to establish a Crisis Standards of Care Plan that addresses crisis standards, allocation of scarce resources and ethical decision-making in a resource-constrained medical environment. This 1/2-day conference will provide stakeholders with robust opportunities to guide the plan's progress, using committee updates as a framework for discussions.
